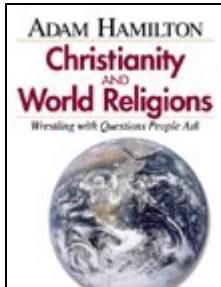

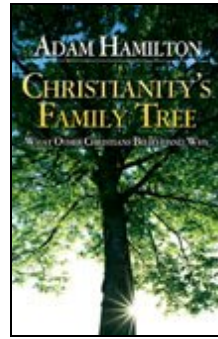
### **Christianity and World Religions - Wrestling with Questions People Ask**

- 6. Christianity**

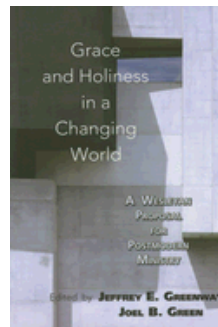
The opening session deals openly and honestly with questions people ask about other religions, including why we should believe the claims of Christianity over those of other faiths. Hamilton interviews leaders from each tradition and includes the taped comments in his remarks. He treats the world religions with respect, recognizing the unique contributions of each and then comparing and contrasting them with Christianity. In the final session, he attempts to distill the essential beliefs of Christianity, in light of the other religious beliefs that have been presented.

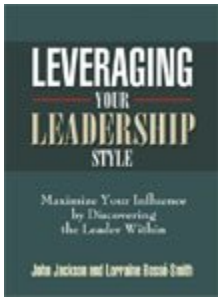
